The Session of the Calvary Presbyterian Church, St. Clairsville, Ohlo is fully satisfied with your ministerial qualifications to lead and assist us in the fulfillment of our corporate and individual mulsistes and hereby contracts with you. Paul Tood to become our transitional commissioned paster for the period of time from October 1, 2020, to March 31, 2021. The Church and Paul Todd may decide now or during this contract to request from the Presbytery status as a Commissioned Lay Pastor.

During this time we expect you to perform the following services:

The Session will maintain its individual and corporate duties in the government and disripline of the congregation and oversight of the church's spiritual interests. The session will elect and send a commissioner to all presbytary meetings (Book of Order G-3.0202a), and relimburse the commissioner's travel expenses upon presentation of an approved expense voucher.
