- Investment Income

- People:
  - o Board of Pensions implications
- Place:
  - o mortgage implications, especially variable-rate mortgages
  - o maintenance vs. benchmarks and considering deferred maintenance
- Program:
  - o alignment with Annual Ministry Plan

## Monitoring:

- Process:
  - o committee (micro) and Session (macro)
  - o transparency vs. familiarity vs. competence
- Tools:
  - o periodic reports: summary vs. detailed
  - o information systems
- Action Plans:
  - Importance of "triggers"
